NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Planning Commission of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, November 22, 2011, at 7:00 PM at Hesse Park Community Building, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard, Rancho Palos Verdes, to consider:

CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT REVISION (CASE NO. ZON2011-00042): A request by AT&T to replace six existing 4' tall antennas with twelve new 8' tall antennas in the same general location. There is currently a set of two antennas located on each of the west, north and east façades of an existing US Bank building, behind plastic screens. Each set of antennas will be replaced with four new antennas in the same location. The existing plastic screens on the west and north façades are proposed to be extended downward to hide the new taller antennas. Additionally, the existing plastic screen on the east façade rooftop is proposed to be increased in height by 3' to hide the new taller antennas. This modified screen will also hide two additional equipment cabinets proposed adjacent to existing equipment located on east façade of the roof.

LOCATION: 29000 Western Avenue (US Bank)

APPLICANT: AT&T Mobility

LANDOWNER: AMDAN Investments

All interested parties are invited to submit written comments and to attend and give testimony. If you have any comments or concerns about the proposed project, please communicate those thoughts in writing to Ms. So Kim, Associate Planner by Tuesday, November 15, 2011. By doing so, you will ensure that your comments are taken into consideration for the staff analysis of the project. Written comments submitted after Tuesday, November 15, 2011, will be given to the Planning Commission on the night of the meeting. Please note that written materials, including emails, submitted to the City are public records and may be posted on the City's website. In addition, City meetings may be televised and may be accessed through the City's website. Accordingly, you may wish to omit personal information from your oral presentation or written materials as it may become part of the public record regarding an item on the agenda.

Only those who have submitted written comments at or prior to, and/or given testimony at the public hearing will receive notification of the decision. The Planning Commission's decision may then be appealed, in writing, to the City Council. The appeal shall set forth the grounds for appeal and any specific action being requested by the appellant. The appeal letter must be filed within fifteen (15) calendar days of the Planning Commission's decision and must be accompanied by a \$2,275.00 appeal fee.

If you would like the opportunity to review the proposed plans, they are on file in the Community Development Department at 30940 Hawthorne Boulevard, Rancho Palos Verdes, and are available for review from 7:30 AM to 5:30 PM Monday through Thursday, and from 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM Friday. Additionally, a Staff Report will be prepared for the November 22nd Planning Commission meeting. On November 18th said report will be available for viewing on the City's website (<http://www.palosverdes.com/rpv/>). Alternatively, a copy of the Staff Report can also be viewed at the Community Development Department at City Hall on the same date.
