



**NOTICE TO VOTERS OF DATE AFTER WHICH NO ARGUMENTS
FOR OR AGAINST A MEASURE
MAY BE SUBMITTED TO THE CITY CLERK**

NOTICE IS GIVEN that a Special Municipal Election is to be held in the City of Rancho Palos Verdes on November 2, 2010, at which there will be submitted to the voters the following measure:

<p>Shall an ordinance be adopted that would enact a new specific plan and related amendments to the City of Rancho Palos Verdes ("City") general plan and zoning ordinance to: (1) allow development of specified facility improvements, including dormitories, on the Marymount College Campus ("Campus") located at 30800 Palos Verdes Drive East; (2) govern the operation of the Campus, and (3) supersede inconsistent provisions of the Municipal Code and prior City land use decisions regarding the Campus?</p>	<p>YES _____</p>	<p>NO _____</p>

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Section 9282(a) of the Elections Code of the State of California, the persons filing an initiative petition pursuant to this article may file a written argument in favor of the measure, and the legislative body of the City may file a written argument, not to exceed 300 words in length, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, against the measure.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that, based upon the time reasonably necessary to prepare and print the arguments and sample ballots for the election, and pursuant to Elections Code Section 9286(b), the City Clerk has fixed 5:30 P.M. on August 16, 2010, as the date after which no arguments for or against the City measure may be submitted to the City Clerk for printing and distribution to the voters as provided in Elections Code Section 9286. Arguments shall be submitted to the City Clerk, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, at Rancho Palos Verdes City Hall, located at 30940 Hawthorne Boulevard, Rancho Palos Verdes, California. Arguments may be changed or withdrawn until and including the date fixed by the City Clerk.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the City Council has determined that rebuttal arguments, not to exceed 250 words in length, as submitted by the author(s) of the direct and opposing arguments, or such persons authorized by the author or a majority of the authors, may be filed with the City Clerk by 5:30 P.M. on August 26, 2010, accompanied by the printed names(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that any ordinance, impartial analysis, or direct argument filed under the authority of the Elections Code will be available for public examination in the City Clerk's office for not less than 10-calendar days from the deadline for the filing of the arguments and analysis. Any rebuttal argument filed under the authority of the Elections Code will be available for public examination in the City Clerk's office for not less than 10-calendar days from the deadline for filing rebuttal arguments.
